

## **Kaiser Health News Reporter Position**

Kaiser Health News, a new nonprofit health news service being launched by the Kaiser Family Foundation, is looking for a reporter to cover and write enterprise stories about health care policy and politics. The job is based in Washington, but the reporter will be encouraged to take occasional trips to write about developments "outside the beltway." We're looking for someone to tackle a wide range of health issues, including health care reform; how the poor get care; how the health care delivery system is working; aging issues, health care disparities and Medicare and Medicaid. We aren't covering medical news. Requirements: experience on either a daily newspaper or magazine, but not necessarily in covering health care; good writing and reporting skills, and an ability to work in a team atmosphere. We'll be launching a new Web site on June 1, and we're making our stories available free to interested news outlets. We have already published in the Washington Post and the Philadelphia Inquirer. Kaiser Family Foundation is a nonprofit that focuses on health care issues and isn't affiliated with Kaiser Permanente.
